



# DESPERATE HOUSECAT RAVEN A879617



**RAVEN** is a survivor! She's a former community cat who arrived at AAC very anemic, extremely thin (under 6 lbs) and dehydrated. We moved her into a foster home for supportive care and a month of antibiotic treatment for a possible blood parasite (commonly acquired from fleas). **RAVEN**'s blood counts are now normal, her appetite is good (she's now 7 lbs), and she has more energy. Because anemia can sometimes reactivate with stress, we want **RAVEN** to be adopted into a quiet home with no other pets and no young children. She loves to be petted, and is a lap cat. **RAVEN** is a little shy and can be easily startled. She will sometimes get cranky when you interrupt her 'all day' nap or her meal time. 😊
