After being adopted and returned the next day (twice!), we moved her into a foster home. **SUSIE** was diagnosed with stomatitis, a serious and very painful condition that can be life threatening if left untreated. A local veterinary clinic removed all of **SUSIE**'s teeth (a common solution to relieve the stomatitis). She has completely recovered, and has no discomfort. **SUSIE** is very social, and **LOVES** to sit in her foster mom's lap. She will solicit attention, wanting to be petted and held. **SUSIE** is good with other cats, but we don't know how she is with dogs or children.
