Adorable **ELIZABETH** has tons of personality! She was brought to AAS after being rescued in the community. She had nerve damage to her left front paw and a broken but healing distal 1/3 left humerus that was fairly displaced. We moved **ELIZABETH** into a foster home for weeks of kennel rest and range of motion PT. The fracture is now healed but in poor alignment, and the nerves have regenerated enough that she can place the paw in the correct position with every step. She will likely gain some strength in the left front leg muscles but may never have a normal stride in this limb. **ELIZABETH** has no idea that her left front paw isn't absolutely perfect. She runs, plays, jumps, and does everything that her foster siblings do, and then some. She is very affectionate, and loves to be held, petted, brushed, etc. She would enjoy having a cat/kitten buddy in her new home.
