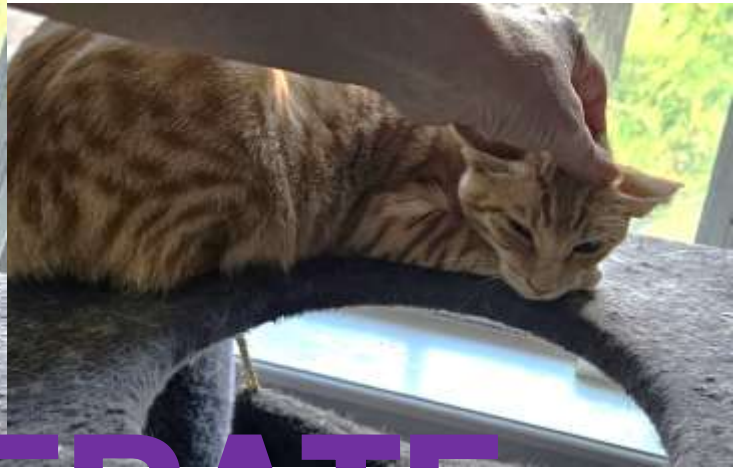




DESPERATE HOUSECAT FRITTER 27479



FRITTER is a shy, nervous kitten who was brought to AAS with his siblings from a community area. His right eye had some mild symblepharon after a URI, and the fused tissues were covering half of his right pupil. During his neuter surgery, the surgeon was able to trim the tissue back so that he has better vision in that eye. **FRITTER** moved into a foster home, and after several weeks of eye medications, all eye tissues have stabilized. He could have a flare up during times of stress, so he needs to be monitored. He is not on any medication at this time. **FRITTER** is still shy with humans, so he is a member of our CACTUS CATS program - <http://austintexas.gov/page/cactus-cats>. He absolutely loves other cats/kittens, and would be happiest in a quiet home with at least one cat buddy. He can be petted, although he is nervous when he sees a hand coming towards him. Once you start petting him, he relaxes and even purrs. **FRITTER** is playful, and interacting with him can help him feel more confident. He'll need some time to adjust to a new environment and may initially hide.
