He also had a toe mass which was successfully removed. This older, very handsome guy has a history of occasional vomiting and diarrhea consistent with inflammation in his GI tract, which are easily treated with OTC meds if they occur. **GREGORY** is not currently on any medication. He is tolerant of other cats but prefers to have his human(s) all to himself. He is very sweet and loves being petted and brushed. He likes being near his people and may be a lap cat.
