Adorable **YASMIN** is friendly, social, and affectionate. She was brought to AAS with a large wound on the inside of her left ankle and a fractured distal tibia very close to the joint. Surgical repair wasn't an option at the shelter due to the open wound, so we moved her into foster care for months of supportive care (including kennel rest). The fracture has healed well, although **YASMIN**'s ankle bends outward a bit. Still, she has tons of energy, running and playing without it bothering her. This ankle may be prone to arthritis in the future, so it should be monitored closely for any issues. **YASMIN** LOVES attention, and has been known to climb up on a shoulder (or even a back)! She even likes belly rubs. She'll greet you and wants to be near you, and is a lap cat it's time to rest. She is fine with other cats/kittens, but slow intros are essential, as she is picky about who her feline friends are.
